Reflection and debate on how to ensure:

Stable relationship

- Close co-operation bonds between the project partners.
- Co-operation perspectives beyond the project duration.
- Well-established contact networks to relevant stakeholders, including policy makers at all levels: local, regional, national and/or EU.



Reflection and debate on how to ensure:

Adoption of project results by relevant institutions

- Integration of project work in to the regular activities of the participating institutions.
- The strategic relevance of project results for as many partners as possible.
- Positive impact of project results at local, regional, national and/or EU level.
- Outside institutions interest to take over any elements from the project (running a developed training course)
- Project perspective beyond the project period.
- Multiplier effect and sustainable impact of project results in its reach considering scope and size of project.



Reflection and debate on how to ensure:

Integrating the results into national systems

- Project approach at least partially coincides with local or national policy aims.
- That project results will lead to innovative development at system level and/or provide useful input to policy development.
- That policy and decision-makers in the partner countries are well and regularly informed about the project.



Reflection and debate on how to ensure:

Quality, transferability and ongoing relevancy

- Development of generic or replicable models in the project.
- Effective and appropriate identification of other sectors, target groups or countries where the results could be used.
- Regular revision and up gradation of project results.



Reflection and debate on how to ensure:

Finding new funding or commercialization

- Identification and provision of European or national funding opportunities for a follow-up.
- Identification and provision of private sponsors.
- Development of a business model which finances at least the staffing necessary to maintain and update the project results.
